Between 2013 and 2019 she served in administration positions as a member of Senate Executive Committee, Head of Biotechnology Department, and the Deputy Dean of the School of Agriculture. Sibonani is the Treasurer for the Zimbabwe Young Academy of Sciences (ZIMYAS) and is also a member of some national committees.
